A National Seminar on "Role of Milk and Milk Products in Health and Disease Prevention" was organized by Indian Dairy Association (West Zone) on 12th September, 2023 at Mumbai under the Chairmanship of Dr. J.B. Prajapati in association with AFSTI, ICT, Shree Vitthaldas Thackersey College, GN Khalsa College and Consumer Society of India. Dr. Prajapati expressed basic views on why milk is pious and cited some quotes from Vedas, signifying the significance of milk and milk products in Indian diet. He welcomed the dignitaries Padmashri Dr. V. Mohan, Chairman and Chief of Diabetology, Madras Diabetic Research Foundation, Chennai; Dr. R.S. Sodhi, President, IDA, New Delhi and Dr. J.V. Parekh, Vice Chairman, IDA (WZ).

Dr. Meenesh Shah, Chairman NDDB stressted on the significance of milk indicating the biological activities of few proteins and bioactives in milk, imparting health benefits to the host. He briefed about NDDB's initiatives in offering milk fortified with Vitamins A & D to 480 government schools.



The keynote address was delivered by **Dr.**V. **Mohan**, who gave an overview of the components in milk and their roles and cited several publications depicting the statistically significant results advocating no negative impact on human health upon



milk consumption. Research findings supporting yoghurt and cheese consumption, specifically was shown to prevent the development of Type 2 Diabetes. He also shared the findings of The Prospective Urban Rural Epidemiology (PURE) study. People consuming milk and milk products was correlated with increased longevity.

Dr. K.D. Aparnathi, Retd. Head, Department of Dairy Chemistry and **Dr. Atanu Jana**, Principal, SMC College of Dairy Science, Anand were **invited as panelist** to this seminar. Students of our college participated in 'Reel making competition' and **Mr. Kevin Bhensdadiya**, 8th Semester, B.Tech. (DT) course bagged the **first prize**.




